- 2) Hydrolysis followed by on-site iSCWO (industrial Super Critical Water Oxidation)
- 3) [Continue studying the use of the Static Detonation Chamber for Non-Contaminated Rocket Motors only](#)

Recommendations 1 & 2 were provided to Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass and Program Manager Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives last year. Number 3 has been added based on the Static Detonation Chamber emerging as a new on-site treatment option.
