### **McKinney named Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass project manager**

Richmond, KY—Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass has announced the appointment of Tom McKinney as project manager for the Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (BGCAPP) project. Effective April 18, McKinney will succeed Mark Seely, who has taken a new position at the U.S. Department of Energy's Oak Ridge Reservation in Tennessee.

McKinney is a Bechtel principal vice president with more than 38 years of project management experience. He has considerable experience in the chemical demilitarization program, having served from 2004 to 2007 as the manager of operations responsible for the Aberdeen, Pueblo and Blue Grass projects. His most recent assignment was associate director for project management and site services at Los Alamos National Laboratory in New Mexico.

After nearly four years as the Bechtel Parsons project manager, Seely will join the Y-12 senior management team at the Oak Ridge Reservation.

Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass is under contract to the Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives (ACWA) program to design, build, systemize, operate and close the BGCAPP. Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass is a joint venture of Bechtel National, Inc., of Frederick, MD, and Parsons Infrastructure and Technology Group, Inc., of Pasadena, CA. The joint venture has four teaming subcontractors: URS Corporation, Battelle Memorial Institute, General Physics and General Atomics.
