Joseph J. Novad is the Technical Director for the Program Executive Office, Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives (PEO ACWA), which is headquartered at the Edgewood Area of Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland.

Mr. Novad joined PEO ACWA in 1997. He is currently responsible for the activities associated with risk management, and systems engineering and operations at the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant in Colorado, and the Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant in Kentucky.

Prior to working for PEO ACWA, Mr. Novad was the Engineering Directorate Team Leader who supervised functional areas within the Edgewood Research, Development and Engineering Center in support of the Program Manager for Chemical Demilitarization's Alternative Technology program. He directed all HD and VX neutralization based technology testing, hydrolyzed HD and VX biodegradation testing, and pilot plant design support. He also directed toxicology studies and analyses of neutralization and biodegradation reaction products.

A native of Pennsylvania, Mr. Novad earned a bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering from Pennsylvania State University. He has twice received the Army's Superior Civilian Service Award.
