The Part B Permit application includes, but is not limited to, types of wastes generated, received, treated and managed, storage and treatment processes, operating parameters, pollution control measures, responses to contingency events, and plans for hazard preparedness/prevention. The Army and Bechtel will submit a Part B operating permit application to continue chemical munition destruction operations.
