



# CHEMICAL AGENT TRANSFER SYSTEM: HOW IT WORKS

The Chemical Agent Transfer System (CHATS) will destroy the contents of three steel containers in storage at the Blue Grass Army Depot. Since first developed, CHATS has successfully destroyed the contents of more than 2,000 steel containers.

- Each steel container will be partially inserted into the CHATS and sealed to prevent the release of any contamination.
- The containers will be drained and the contents will be transferred into neutralization reactors.
- The reaction chemicals and mechanics are similar to those to be used at the Blue Grass Chemical Agent Destruction Pilot Plant.
