Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives

Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives, known as ACWA, is responsible for the destruction of the three deteriorating steel containers stored at the Blue Grass Army Depot.



Blue Grass Army Depot

The Blue Grass Army Depot is the installation on which the Blue Grass Chemical Activity is located. It is the permit holder for the chemical activity's Part B Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit.



Blue Grass Chemical Activity

The Blue Grass Chemical Activity is responsible for the safe storage and maintenance of the chemical weapons stockpile at the Blue Grass Army Depot.

The Chemical Materials Agency is responsible for the safe storage and maintenance of all the U.S. chemical weapons stockpiles.

A team from the Edgewood Chemical Biological Center will use the Chemical Agent Transfer System to drain and neutralize the contents of the steel containers.
