



Community Chemical Weapons Groups to Hold Public Meeting on June 10

Richmond, Ky. -- The Kentucky Chemical Demilitarization Citizens' Advisory Commission (CAC) and the Chemical Destruction Community Advisory Board (CDCAB) will meet on Tuesday, June 10 at 1:30 p.m. in Rooms A & B on the lobby level at Eastern Kentucky University's Carl D. Perkins Building located on Kit Carson Drive. The meeting is open to the public and accessible to people with disabilities.

Beginning this month, the CAC and CDCAB will meet jointly to receive updates on the chemical weapons destruction project. Local citizens are encouraged to attend and share their views with community leaders. There will be opportunities for public comment throughout the meeting.

The CAC, chaired by Dr. Doug Hindman, is a governor-appointed group that represents community and state interests to the U.S. Army and the Department of Defense.

The CDCAB, co-chaired by Madison County Judge-Executive Kent Clark and Craig Williams, executive director of the Chemical Weapons Working Group, is an independent subcommittee of the CAC. It is made up of a diverse group of community leaders who represent the views and concerns of the local community regarding Kentucky's chemical weapons disposal program.
