## THREE STAGE PERMIT

**The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment issued a Research Development and Demonstration (RD&D) Permit to:**

- U.S. Army Pueblo Chemical Depot
- Bechtel National, Inc.
- Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives Program

The permit allows for the construction of the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant.

### **STAGE ONE: Site Preparation**



The RD&D permit for Stage One was issued by the state health department on July 1, 2004. Construction work included site clearing and grading, fencing and installation of high-mast lighting and underground utilities.

### **STAGE TWO: Support Facilities**

The RD&D permit for Stage Two was issued by the state health department on June 23, 2005. Stage Two construction is in progress and includes support buildings, facilities and above ground utilities.

### **STAGE THREE: Processing Facilities**

Permit modification request for Stage Three was submitted to the state health department on December 1, 2006. It covers the plant processing facilities. Approval of this RD&D permit modification request would allow Bechtel and the Army to proceed with the construction, but not the operation, of the facilities associated with the processing of agent, munitions, and secondary waste.
