Gentlemen:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) has made a final determination to approve the Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Permit (Permit No. CO-20-09-02-01) for the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP) Facility in accordance with 6 CCR 1007-3, Section 100.511. An electronic copy of the final Permit will follow this letter.

The Division did not receive any comments on the draft permit during the public comment period ending on August 31, 2020.

Issuance of this permit decision constitutes final agency action for the purposes of judicial review. Since the Division did not receive any public comments on the draft Permit, the Permit will become effective immediately upon receipt of this letter in accordance with 6 CCR 1007-3, Section 100.511(b)(2). Procedures for appeal of State RCRA permits are found in 6 CCR 1007-3, Section 100.514.
