Approval - Class 2 Permit Modification #51 (Partial)
Research Development and Demonstration Permit
Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP)**

- Extension of the expiration date for the PCAPP Hazardous Waste Research Development and Demonstration (RD&D) Permit is approved. The expiration date is extended from December 31, 2015 to December 31, 2016 as requested by Class 2 Permit Modification Request #51. It is necessary to extend the expiration date since permitted hazardous waste management activities have not yet begun at PCAPP and this RD&D Permit was issued to authorize up to one year of hazardous waste operations (i.e., 365 operational days). The extension of the expiration date is the only portion of Permit Modification Request #51 being approved at this time. The remainder of Permit Modification Request #51 consists of a Pilot Test Demonstration Plan and a permit decision regarding that portion of the request will be addressed in the future.
- This notification of approval for a Class 2 modification is provided consistent with the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations, Section 100.63f(1).
