What is the purpose of the Environmental Assessment?

The U.S. Army and its contractor, Bechtel National, Inc., operate the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP) that is currently destroying munitions containing mustard agent stored at the Pueblo Chemical Depot (PCD).

This Environmental Assessment (EA) evaluates the environmental effects of the Army's proposed action to install and operate one or more Static Detonation Chambers (SDCs) at Pueblo Chemical Depot in Colorado. The proposed SDCs would eliminate current safety and schedule risks associated with the destruction of mustard munitions. SDCs would also be utilized to destroy any agent-contaminated explosive components and overpacked munitions discovered/create during PCAPP Main Plant operations and items recovered during cleanup of solid waste management units at PCD.
