IMPORTANT NOTE: THIS NOTICE IS ABOUT THE PCAPP RD&D CHEMICAL DEMILITARIZATION PERMIT, NOT THE HAZARDOUS WASTE STORAGE PERMIT

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the "Division") is notifying the public that a Class 2 modification to the Hazardous Waste Research Development and Demonstration (RD&D) Permit for the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP) to incorporate a Contingency Plan was approved with changes on January 28, 2015. The Division received the Class 2 permit modification request from the Permittees on January 24, 2013. The current Hazardous Waste RD&D Permit for the PCAPP facility became effective July 31, 2004. The PCAPP facility is located in the northeast area of PCD which is located east of Pueblo, Colorado.

Owners or operators of hazardous waste treatment, storage or disposal facilities are required to have a Contingency Plan for their facility. The plan must be designed to minimize hazards to human health or the environment from fires, explosions, or any unplanned sudden or non-sudden releases of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents. The plan describes specific actions that will be taken in the event of a fire, explosion or releases of hazardous waste at the facility. It also specifies who will lead the response and what capabilities the facility has to respond. Additionally, the Contingency Plan describes arrangements with other available responders to aid in emergency response if necessary.

Notification of approval for this Class 2 modification is provided consistent with Section 100.63(f)(1) of the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations. The final permit and supporting documents are available for review during normal business hours at the offices specified below:
