Omichinski Named Bechtel Pueblo Team Project Manager

PUEBLO, Colorado – March 18, 2011 -- Bechtel Pueblo Team (BPT) has announced the appointment of Doug Omichinski as project manager for the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP) project. Doug succeeds Paul Henry, who has taken a new position at Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) in New Mexico. He will begin his new duties on March 28.

Omichinski has held three previous roles at Pueblo; first as site construction manager, then design/build manager, and finally as deputy project manager. He was deputy project manager when Pueblo won the Construction Team of the Year award. His most recent assignment was the Bechtel Systems and Infrastructure, Inc. manager of Construction in Frederick, Maryland.

After nearly seven years as project manager for PCAPP, Henry is leaving to become the new principal associate director for capital projects at LANL.

Bechtel National, Inc. (BNI) is under contract to the U. S. Department of Defense to design, build, test, operate and close PCAPP, which will neutralize a stockpile of chemical weapons containing mustard agent at the U.S. Army Pueblo Chemical Depot in Pueblo, Colorado. BNI is the prime contractor, with URS Corporation, Battelle Memorial Institute and Parsons Infrastructure and Technology as major teaming subcontractors.
