**What is the
purpose of this
permit
modification
request?**

The U.S. Army and its contractor, Bechtel National, Inc., operate the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP) that is currently destroying munitions containing mustard agent stored at the Pueblo Chemical Depot (PCD). The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment issued the Research, Development, and Demonstration Permit on July 1, 2004.

The Army and Bechtel are applying for three (3) Class 2 permit modifications:

Modification #139, Removal of Conductive Mats from the Receiving and Traveling Area and Munition Monitoring Areas:

This permit modification request proposes removing the conductive mats from the Receiving and Traveling Area (room no. ERB-106) and from each of the three Munition Monitoring Areas, (room nos. ERB-113, -114, -115) in the Enhanced Reconfiguration Building. It also proposes to remove these mats from the emergency equipment listing in Attachment J, Hazard Preparedness and Prevention Plan of the Permit. Additionally, this permit modification request revises language to clarify that conductive mats are not required in the Explosive Containment Rooms (room nos. ERB-110, -111, -112).

Modification #142, Contingency Plan Update:

This permit modification request corrects and clarifies language, corrects typographic and formatting errors, removes objects from select figures so they are no longer considered For Official Use Only per Department of Defense Directive 5400.07. This permit modification request incorporates lessons learned during the last few months of operations and performing drills. It also adds response actions that will provide a contingency plan that minimizes hazards to human health or the environment from fires, explosions, or any unplanned sudden or non-sudden release of hazardous waste or hazardous waste constituents to air, soil, or surface water.

Modification #159, Stainless Steel Plate – Floor Coating Wear Protection:

This permit modification request proposes the installation of stainless steel floor plating in areas where equipment movement is wearing down the concrete coating. Initially, PCAPP proposes to install a stainless-steel plate in the southern most Automated Guided Vehicle corridor turn around area. Provided that the plate performs as expected at this location, PCAPP will install stainless steel plate at other locations where equipment movement is wearing down coatings (i.e., other areas in the Automated Guided Vehicle corridor or Munitions Body Storage Building).

A public meeting to discuss this permit modification request will be held in Pueblo at the District Attorney's office, 701 Court Street (1st floor conference room), at 2:00 p.m. on July 26, 2017.
