U.S. ARMY PUEBLO CHEMICAL DEPOT, Colo. – On Wednesday, July 27, the Program Executive Office, Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives (PEO ACWA) will hold a special event recognizing the destruction of more than 383,000 mustard agent-filled 105mm projectiles at the Pueblo Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (PCAPP). The event will take place at 9 a.m. MDT at the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center, Jackson Conference Center, 210 North Santa Fe Ave. in downtown Pueblo.
