## Class 2 Modification- Additional Storage

- Class 2 Modification dated November 20, 2020
  - Public Comment Period
    - November 24, 2020 through January 27, 2021
  - Temporary Authorization Request
    - December 14<sup>th</sup> start date requested for storage in the igloos to coincide with PCAPP operations of the 105MM Campaign.
- Background
  - Existing structures are permitted for 300 rounds. Current configuration becomes filled between 175-230 rounds.
  - Decrease in capacity has led to a need for additional storage
  - Current technology to destroy overpacked/ leakers is not available.





## Class 2 Modification- Additional Storage

- Proposal
  - (4) four existing empty ammunitions storage structures in the Chemical Limited Area requested to become RCRA permitted storage
  - Existing structures are currently managed as interim status under Compliance Order #06-01-05-01.
  - Items stored in the igloos will be:
    - Overpacked munitions awaiting destruction in the Static Detonations Chamber (SDC) or Explosive Destruction System (EDS)
    - Containerized leaker waste (PPE, Shrouding, pallets, etc)

## Class 2 Modification- Additional Storage

- Net Storage increase of 23.3%
- New Storage total is 28,875 gallons
- G1110 decrease in Secondary Waste Storage as offset
