



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

Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (BGCAPP) EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AT BGCAPP

Your involvement in the Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (BGCAPP) project is important to us, and we're committed to keeping you informed. In fact, your community and local workforce will play a key role in helping to achieve the BGCAPP mission. People with many different skills — engineers, technicians, construction workers, managers and administrative specialists — will be needed to build and operate the pilot plant. As a result, we want to keep you up to date with the latest information on employment and subcontracting opportunities.

Job Opportunities

Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass — the systems contractor responsible for the design, construction, testing, operation and closure of BGCAPP — is responsible for the employment and subcontracting necessary to get the job done. Bechtel Parsons currently has about 100 non-manual employees at the company's Richmond, Ky., office, and about 30 construction workers at the nearby construction site. Another 200 employees currently work at other locations, primarily at the company's design center in Pasadena, Calif. Some of those jobs will soon be relocated to Richmond as design work is completed in Pasadena and the engineering team transitions to the field office.

Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass expects to hire about 35 engineers and other non-manual employees during the next six months. The company also anticipates hiring about 100 construction workers in the next six months. If you are interested in a construction job, contact the Central Kentucky Building and Construction Trades Council for information on employment programs for apprenticeships and skilled-trades workers.

Procurement and Subcontract Opportunities

Construction work is ongoing and suppliers and subcontractors will continue to be needed to support the project. Local business owners are encouraged to bid on equipment, materials and subcontracts to support BGCAPP construction activities. If you are a business owner interested

in becoming a supplier or subcontractor to the BGCAPP project, here are some helpful tips:
