Richmond, Ky. -- The Chemical Destruction Community Advisory Board (CDCAB) will meet on Tuesday, March 11 at 1:30 p.m. in Rooms A & B on the lobby level at Eastern Kentucky University's Carl D. Perkins Building located on Kit Carson Drive. The event is accessible to people with disabilities.

The advisory board, which is co-chaired by Madison County Judge-Executive Kent Clark and Craig Williams, executive director of the Chemical Weapons Working Group, will discuss topics related to the Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant. There will be opportunities for public comment throughout the meeting.

As diverse representatives of the local community, board members provide advice and citizen input on issues regarding the chemical weapons destruction project at the Blue Grass Army Depot.

All board meetings are open to the public.

The governor-appointed Kentucky Chemical Demilitarization Citizens' Advisory Commission will meet at the conclusion of the CDCAB meeting.
